


The Coventry Room

This space is named after Henry Coventry, who lived at West Lodge in the seventeenth century and was Secretary of State to Charles II.

It features its own conservatory, air conditioning, ceiling fans, and has direct access to the bar terrace and to the 35 acres of the Beale Arboretum surrounding the hotel.
