


John Evelyn Room

The John Evelyn Suite is one of the finest banqueting and conference rooms in North London, named after the diarist John Evelyn who visited West Lodge in 1676.

It features a high ceiling, two large sash windows, air conditioning, chandeliers, original portraits by Mary Beale, a beautiful conservatory and an equally lovely terrace, with direct access to the 35 acres of the Beale Arboretum surrounding the hotel, beautiful views, and easy access to the front entrance.
